Further topics are satirical reflections on operatic activities in early eighteenth-century Italy and practices of opera censorship, artist-operas or definitions of romantic and epic opera. The essays are written in an accessible, essentially non-technical language and are expected to make both a profitable and a pleasurable reading for literary scholars as well as musicologists and general art lovers.

Geary further argues that Wagner's Ring cycle can be understood as the composer's attempt to reclaim the mythic significance of the *Oedipus* myth in the service of his own aesthetic aims.
