Ego Scriptor Et Petits Poemes Abstracts:

Poetry and Radical Politics in Fin de Siècle France Patrick McGuinness, 2015 Poetry and Radical Politics in fin de siècle France explores the relations between poetry and politics in France in the last decade of the 19th century. The period covers perhaps the most important developments in modern French poetry from the post Commune climate that spawned the decadent movement through to the allegedly ivory towered aestheticism of Mallarmé and the Symbolists. In terms of French politics, history and culture, the period was no less dramatic with the legacy of the Commune, the political and financial instability that followed the anarchist campaigns, the Dreyfus affair and the growth of Action française. Patrick McGuinness argues that the anarchist politics of many Symbolist poets is a reaction to their own isolation and to poetry's anxious relations with the public too difficult to be widely read. Symbolist poets react to the loss of poetry's centrality among the arts by delegating their radicalism to prose; they can call in prose for the overthrow of the state and support anarchist bombers while at the same time writing poems about dribbling fountains and dazzling sunsets for each other. This study demonstrates the connections between the anti Symbolist reaction of the école romane of 1891 in which Charles Maurras first made his name and the far right cultural politics of Action française in the early 20th century. It also redefines many of the debates about late 19th century French poetry by putting an argument forward for the political engagements of the Symbolists while the French intellectual as a national icon was being forged. McGuinness insists on profound continuities between the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th in terms of cultural politics, literary debate and poetic theory and shows how politics is to be found in unexpected ways in the least political seeming literature of the period. The famous line by Peguy that everything begins in mysticism and ends in politics has an appealing sweep and grace. This book has its own more modest and specific version of a similar journey: it begins in Mallarmé and ends in Maurras. **Reading Paul Valéry** Paul

Gifford, Brian Stimpson, 1998 Originally published in 1999, this was the first comprehensive account of the work of the French modernist writer Paul Valéry. **Politics, Poetics, Affect** Stephen M. Hart, 2013-08-19 This book seeks to re-vision the life and work of the Peruvian poet César Vallejo 1892-1938. It consists of ten essays grouped into three complementary sections on Politics, Poetics and Affect. In Part I William Rowe draws out the latent layers of political meaning in Vallejo's pre-political work. Trilce Adam Feinstein weighs the evidence for and against the case that there was a rift between the two most important Latin American poets of the twentieth century, Vallejo and Pablo Neruda, and David Bellis compares and contrasts Vallejo's Spanish Civil War poetry with that composed by Neruda and the Cuban poet Nicolás Guillén. In Part II Dominic Moran provides a line-by-line dissection of Vallejo's favourite poem of his early period, *El palco estrecho*. Adam Sharman offers a close reading of Poem XXIII of Trilce. Paloma Yannakakis looks at the role played by the human body in Vallejo's poetics while Michelle Clayton reviews the ways in which animals are represented in Vallejo's poetry. In Part III Santi Zegarra discusses the influence that Vallejo's poetry has had on his film making. Eduardo González Via reveals how he re-created

Vallejo's experience of imprisonment in his novel *Vallejo en los infiernos* while Stephen Hart compares and contrasts the two main muses of Vallejo's early poetry his niece Otilia Vallejo Gamboa and the woman he met in Lima Otilia Villanueva Pajares

Sound Michel Chion, 2015-12-17 First published in French in 1998 revised in 2010 and appearing here in English for the first time Michel Chion's *Sound* addresses the philosophical interpretive and practical questions that inform our encounters with sound Chion considers how cultural institutions privilege some sounds above others and how spurious distinctions between noise and sound guide the ways we hear and value certain sounds He critiques the tenacious tendency to understand sounds in relation to their sources and advocates acousmatic listening listening without visual access to a sound's cause to disentangle ourselves from auditory habits and prejudices Yet sound can no more be reduced to mere perceptual phenomena than encapsulated in the sciences of acoustics and physiology As Chion reminds us and explores in depth a wide range of linguistic sensory cultural institutional and media and technologically specific factors interact with and shape sonic experiences Interrogating these interactions Chion stimulates us to think about how we might open our ears to new sounds become more nuanced and informed listeners and more fully understand the links between how we hear and what we do
