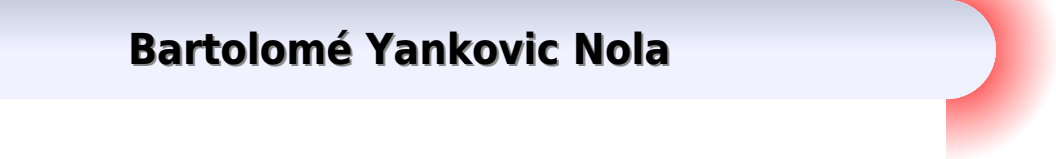

Gametogénesis y genoma humano Milos Pawlowski, El ADN biológico contenido en el esperma se forma mediante el proceso llamado gametogénesis. Consiste en diferentes fases después de las cuales se forman las células sexuales masculinas y femeninas. La estructura del ADN proporciona un mecanismo para la herencia. La conformación que adopta el ADN depende del nivel de hidratación, la secuencia del ADN, la cantidad y la dirección del superenrollamiento, las modificaciones químicas de las bases, el tipo y la concentración de iones metálicos y la presencia de poliaminas en solución.

Introducción a la Biología Celular está diseñado para proporcionar los fundamentos de la biología celular que son requeridos para comprender los aspectos biomédicos así como también los más amplios aspectos biológicos que afectan nuestras vidas. El texto es corto y simple y se ha reducido el vocabulario técnico a un mínimo. En su segunda edición el libro se ha actualizado completamente hasta la fecha con un nuevo énfasis sobre genomas que incluye una visión general de la secuencia del genoma humano y un nuevo capítulo sobre cómo evolucionaron los genes y los genomas. Se ha agregado también un capítulo sobre Genética, Meiosis y Bases Moleculares de la Herencia. También hay nuevas secciones sobre muchos tópicos que están frecuentemente en las noticias que incluyen las células madre, clonación, micromatrices de DNA, muerte celular programada y cáncer. Una característica central del libro es el gran número de preguntas que son presentadas en los márgenes del texto y al final de cada capítulo. Estas están diseñadas para estimular a los estudiantes a pensar sobre lo que ellos han leído y animarlos a detenerse y analizar lo que han comprendido. Las respuestas a todas las preguntas se reúnen al final del libro en muchos casos estas proporcionan un comentario o una perspectiva alternativa sobre el material procesado en el texto principal.

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
