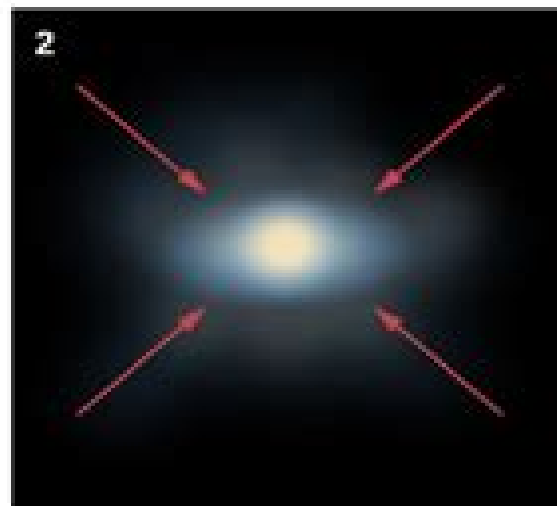

Primordial hydrogen cloud.

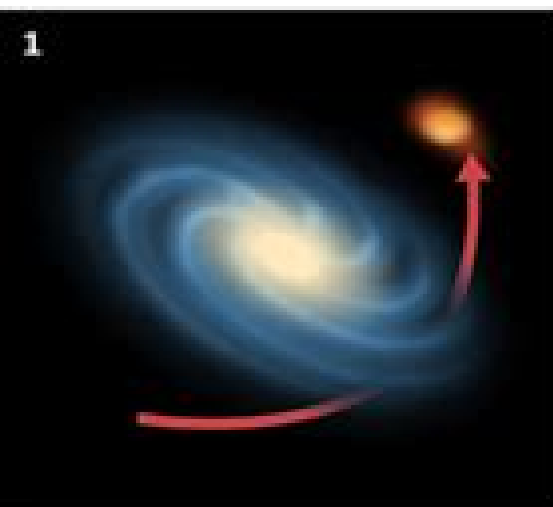


Cloud collapses under gravity.

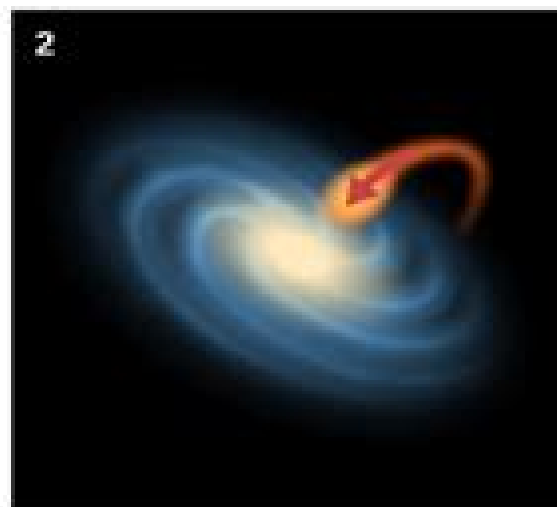


Large bulge of ancient stars dominates galaxy.

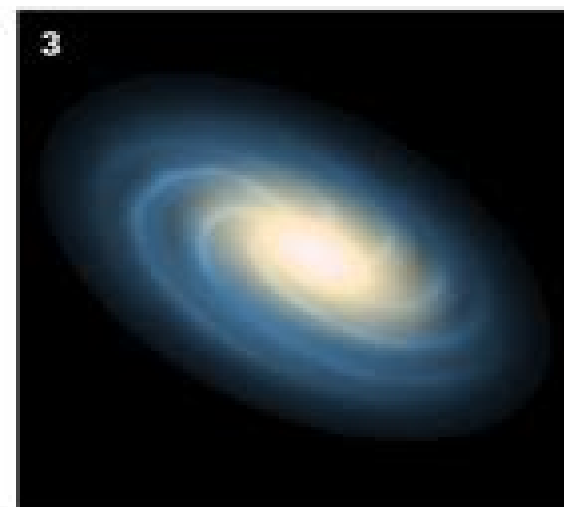
