Miceli,2019-11-06 This book explores the insights that can be gained by looking at the criminal justice system from an economic point of view It provides an economic analysis of the institutional structure and function of the criminal justice system how its policies are formulated and how they affect behavior Yet it goes beyond an examination of specific policies to address the broad question of how law influences behavior For example it examines how concepts such as the possibility of redemption affect the decisions of repeat offenders and whether individual responsibility is or should be a pre requisite for punishment Finally the book argues that in addition to the threat of criminal sanctions law inculcates principles of acceptable behavior among citizens by asserting that certain acts are against the law This expressive function of law can influence behavior to the extent that at least some people in society are receptive to such a message For these people the moral content of law has more than mere symbolic value and consequently it can expand the scope of traditional law enforcement while lowering its cost Another goal of the book is therefore to use economic theory to assess this dualistic function of law by specifically recognizing how its policies can both internalize an ethic of obedience to the law
