


INTRODUCTION

Since the late 20th century, there has been a popular perception that democracies and to be deorganized and chaotic, which (they claim) makes them both ungovernable and unproductive. Liberal democracies, on the other hand, claim that their systems, while (admittedly) more difficult to manage, provide vestly expenior qualitative and quantitative results for their citizens. This study aimed to test the economic results of liberal democracies with that for other regimes by comparing a measure of economic performance per capita to a measure of democratic national governance.

THE DATE


The author combined publicly available gross domestic product per capital (GDF) data compiled by the World Sank with democracy index (CI) data compiled by the Economial Intelligence Unit for 164 countries in the year 2021 into a single Excel spreadonest. GDP ranged over three orders of magnitude and OI ranged from 0.32 to 9.75.






LINEAR REGRESSION

The two measures showed a highly non-linear correlation, necessitating a non-linear regression model using SPSS statistical software.



EXPONENTIAL REGRESSION

The data fit an exponential regression model with a gostive stope of 5.66 x 10°. Pearson's R°. however, was a retailively weak 0.390. Thus, more democratic governance dearly provided vasify superior economic performance, but there were significant confounding factors.



FUTURE RESEARCH

Future research will be needed to identify the combunding factors and quantify their significance. for national economic performance. Another avenue for future research will be longitudinal studies to comitate economic development with democratic governance over time. Finally, GDP per cepts is not the only, and arquisbly not the most important, measure of citizens' welfare. It is just the most convenient to measure.
