organized in Brest and again one year later in Paris each time showing increased attendance and interest. The success of these meetings and the fact that similar activities were taking place in other European countries especially Great Britain and Germany led to the idea of an annual European Conference providing a forum for theorists and practitioners interested in the object oriented programming paradigm. Breaking these restrictions might require specific software or tools, which may or may not be legal depending on the circumstances and local laws.
