Einstein's Clocks, Poincaré's Maps Peter Galison, 2004 In May 1905 Einstein published his theory of relativity changing time forever This title is a dramatic account of the quest to synchronize time that culminated in the revolutionary theory As Peter Galison argues relativity was borne of urgent practical necessity Clocks and trains telegraphs and colonial conquest the challenges of the late 19th century provided an indispensable real world background to the theoretical breakthrough Europe's burgeoning rail network Only a century ago the continent had hundred of time zones and no universal system for synchronizing them Given that local time could vary from town to town scheduling rail services was hard but vital not least to stop trains from colliding as they hurtled in opposite directions along single tracks In his role as president of the French Bureau of Longitude a remit of which was to map colonial Africa Henri Poincaré grappled with a similar issue Synchronized clocks set by telegraph signal from Paris were necessary to determine longitude and provide the precise coordinates his cartographers needed to tell the story of these two giants whose concrete preoccupations engaged them in a silent race towards a theory that overturned 200 years received thinking **Einstein's Clocks, Poincaré's Maps** Peter Louis Galison, 2003 In May 1905 Albert Einstein changed time forever his theory of relativity had practical consequences that changed the world Only a century ago Europe had a huge number of local time zones and no proper system of synchronizing them This threatened chaos particularly on the railways and communications Synchronized time was necessary to create timetables for passengers and stop trains from crashing as they hurtled in opposite directions along single tracks

LaRue, 2006 Since 1993 Supreme Court precedent has asked judges to serve as gatekeepers to their expert witnesses admitting only reliable scientific testimony Lacking a strong background in science however some judges admit dubious scientific testimony packages by articulate practitioners while others reject reliable evidence that is unreasonably portrayed as full of holes Seeking a balance between undue deference and undeserved skepticism Caudill and LaRue draw on the philosophy of science to help judges juries and advocates better understand its goals and limitations
