Crawl beneath smoke to escape a home fire. If you have time, take your dogs with you, but don't endanger yourself. Activate the closest fire alarm system.

Take a deep breath and wait 15 minutes after the fire is extinguished before contacting 911. Fires burn oxygen quicker than they can be refilled.

Get inside, move away from windows, and remain there until the shaking stops. Outside, go beneath a bridge or building. Avoid electricity wires, trees, and barriers. Avoid damaged buildings and leave if unsafe.

Check on others who may need assistance.



Check the weather forecast and make sure you know when the rain is supposed to stop.

If you live in a flood-prone area, consider moving valuables to higher ground. Know your evacuation plan and prepare your emergency kit.

Find out if there's an evacuation center in your area.



Turn off the power and turn on all the lights in your home.

Do not use candles or open flames as this can cause a fire hazard. Close all windows and doors, even if it's just for a few minutes.

Make sure you have food, water and other supplies for at least 72 hours in case of power outages or emergencies that may happen during the storm.
