

The idea of using 'mind maps' for educational purposes was first developed by Tony Buzan, an educational psychologist, in *Use Your Mind* (1974). According to this theory concepts and arguments are more efficiently understood and remembered if presented in the form of 'key words' which summarise the subject in question, and Ken Cole's book does exactly that in a very witty but informative way. *Understanding Economics* provides for lecturers a short guide to efficient lecture notes and to students a way of using those notes for effective learning. Of course the book is no substitute to traditional methods of teaching, rather it should be seen as an attempt to make studying less boring and thus more productive. It is interesting to note here, apart from the essence, the actual appearance of the book; it is set using a font that imitates a sort of artistic handwriting. But above all, I enjoyed Phil Evans' highly political and extremely clever cartoons. As the saying goes, a picture can

substitute for a thousand words. See for yourselves!

According to Stephen Cullenberg, the ongoing debate within Marxian theory over Marx's assertion that the rate of profit has a tendency to fall has resisted resolution because proponents and critics have approached the issue from incommensurable theoretical standpoints. Although Cullenberg's declared aim is to demonstrate that distinct theories 'impart irreducibly different meanings' (p.2) to concepts they

employ, he really merely assumes without apparent supporting argument a highly contextual theory of meaning, which treats theoretical terms as implicitly defined by theories employing them.

Cullenberg claims that the 'traditional debate' over the tendency of the rate of profit to fall has proceeded from the shared assumption that the capitalist economy is an 'Hegelian totality' whose essence is
