Aims and intended learning outcomes

The article aims to explain and promote the importance of caring for the psychological needs of people who have become physically ill and require healthcare services. It seeks to identify the skills, knowledge and personal qualities needed to assess patients' psychological needs, and deliver appropriate and realistic psychological care with the resources available. Introduction

Florence Nightingale suggested many possible reasons for symptoms of ill health experienced by patients that were not attributed to illness. These included poor hygiene and diet, lack of light and lack of punctuality in care delivery (Nightingale 1859). These factors suggest discomfort rather than disease, but need to be dealt with to promote patients' recovery from illness. Other factors include anxiety, information overload, sensory deprivation, disruption to normal activities of living and having to adjust to a communal care environment.

The nature of care

Watson (1998) suggested that care was 'the essence of nursing and the most central and unifying focus for nursing practice'. In the years since, there has been increasing interest in the nature of care, caring, and modes of care delivery in nursing. There are now many studies and theories about caring in different contexts.
