Land and Revolution in Iran, 1960–1980 Eric J. Hooglund, 2014-07-03 Carried out by the government of the shah between 1962 and 1971 the Iranian land reform was one of the most ambitious such undertakings in modern Middle Eastern history Yet beneath apparent statistical success the actual accomplishments of the program in terms of positive benefits for the peasantry were negligible Later the resulting widespread discontent of thousands of Iranian villagers would contribute to the shah s downfall In the first major study of the effects of this widely publicized program Eric Hooglund s analysis demonstrates that the primary motives behind the land reform were political Attempting to supplant the near absolute authority of the landlord class over the countryside the central government hoped to extend its own authority throughout
