THE REFERRAL

The process starts by a family being referred to an FGC service. The person who makes the referral is the 'referrer'. They will usually know and be working with the child or family. This could be a social worker, teacher or health visitor for example.

INDEPENDENT COORDINATOR APPOINTED

An independent coordinator is then appointed. Their job is to help families plan for their PGCs. They help families to think about the plans and decisions that need to be made. They are neutral. This means that the coordinator will:

- Not influence a family to make a particular decision.
- Be independent from any social worker from children's services that may be working with a family.
