heavy hearts the community released floating lanterns into the sea each carrying a message of love and farewell to Zevolon Menorahteevah and Gahd The lanterns floated on the water illuminating the night sky and for a moment it felt as if the spirits of the young ones were guiding them to a place of eternal serenity In the aftermath of the mourning period life in Dimona began to slowly return to a new normal While the pain of loss remained the community vowed to carry forward the lessons learned from this tragedy They would cherish every moment hold their loved ones close and always remember the three young souls who had touched their lives in such profound ways Though the scars of grief would never fully fade the unity and love that emerged from those 30 days of mourning would forever be etched in the collective memory of the Hebrew Israelite community in Dimona a testament to the enduring power of faith compassion and the strength found in supporting one another through the darkest of times **Stepping Into Zion** Janice W.
