The Major Works of Heinrich Von Kleist Robert E. Helbling, 1975 Nightmare a politically explosive murder trial in the middle of the Vietnam War **Desire's Sway** James M. McGlathery, 1983 In *Desire's Sway* James M McGlathery investigates the role of suppressed sexual desire in the works of the important German author Heinrich von Kleist In contrast to the past hundred years of Kleist criticism which has been predominately from the standpoints of ideology moral philosophy and abstract thought McGlathery views Kleist as a subtly ironic humorist *Desire's Sway* is a study of Kleist's plays and stories as written in the spirit of the older comic traditions of Lustspiel and commedia dell arte Belatedly acknowledged as one of Germany's greatest writers Kleist has previously been regarded by critics especially the existentialists as a deeply troubled writer whose works are expressions of a tragic view of man's destiny in an incomprehensible world McGlathery provides a well documented argument that Kleist is not the enigmatic problematical genius he is often portrayed to be but rather a lighthearted cultivator of the traditions of romantic comedy The introduction serves as a guide to the various critical assessments of Kleist and the notes and bibliography supply broad and detailed reference to secondary sources **Heinrich von Kleist : the major works** Robert E. Helbling, 1975 Kleist's Aristocratic Heritage and Das Käthchen von Heilbronn William C. Reeve, 1991-09-12 Kleist was an important dramatist at the beginning of the nineteenth century and *Käthchen* was one of his greatest stage successes Reeve presents a brief outline of the Kleist family involvement in the Prussian aristocracy and Kleist's reactions to his background He also surveys the literary critics attempts to come to terms with *Käthchen* noting a revisionist trend which associates Kleist with the bourgeois liberalism of his time While acknowledging the influence of the German Enlightenment Reeve argues that the most significant influence on Kleist was his noble heritage Reeve's close textual analysis of *Das Käthchen von Heilbronn* uses the model of the aristocrat which draws upon Nietzsche's *Was ist vornehm* and the works of Anthony Ludovici John H Kautsky and others a model which has remained virtually unchanged since the Middle Ages Reeve examines Kleist's use of symbolic and descriptive names in *Käthchen* showing how they emphasize his ties to the aristocratic and compares Kleist's drama to two other plays featuring socially forbidden love Friedrich Schiller's *Kabale und Liebe* and Friedrich Hebbel's *Agnes Bernauer* Despite his efforts to the contrary Heinrich von Kleist was unable to ignore or deny his aristocratic heritage It left an indelible mark on his works especially as Reeve demonstrates *Das Käthchen von Heilbronn* **Historical Dictionary of German Literature to 1945** William Grange, 2010-12-18 *Historical Dictionary of German Literature to 1945* covers a wide swath of literary analysis and achievement from Old High German lays and ecclesiastical encomia to Middle High German epics sagas and love lyrics While extensive in its chronological dimension the *Historical Dictionary of German Literature to 1945* is equally comprehensive in the geographical and genre areas it covers The history of this period in German literature is told through a detailed chronology an introductory essay a comprehensive bibliography and over 200 cross referenced dictionary entries on poetry
