Fue publicada por primera vez como serial en *The Strand Magazine* en 1901 y al año siguiente en forma de libro debido a su enorme éxito. Desaparecido en las cataratas de Reichenbach cuando resolvía el caso de El problema final, la última historia de Las aventuras de Sherlock Holmes, en el 4 de El Canon, el gran detective reaparece ocho años después en esta novela a medio camino entre el género gótico de terror y la historia de detectives, gracias a la presión popular sobre su autor que había decidido abandonar los relatos de Sherlock Holmes. Henry Baskerville, último vestigio de una antiquísima familia, se ve obligado a viajar de Canadá al Reino Unido a causa de la repentina muerte de su tío Charles en extrañas circunstancias. A su llegada descubre que entre otros misterios relacionados con la muerte de Sir Charles existe una vieja leyenda en los alrededores del paraje de Dartmoor sobre un enorme sabueso que merodea por el lugar y que está relacionado con una vieja maldición familiar. El doctor James Mortimer, amigo de la familia, requiere los servicios del afamado detective Sherlock Holmes para que arroje luz sobre un caso tan oscuro, confrontando las certidumbres de la ciencia y la razón con las leyendas y supersticiones del pasado. El detective acepta el reto y se dispone a viajar a Devon para resolver el caso.

The Hound of the Baskerville 1902 Arthur Conan Doyle, 2015-02-18 Sir Charles Baskerville baronet is found dead on the grounds of his country house Baskerville Hall The cause is ascribed to a heart attack Fearing for the safety of Sir Charles's nephew and the only known heir Sir Henry Baskerville Dr James Mortimer travels to London and asks Sherlock Holmes for help in figuring out the case Mortimer explains that the Baskerville family is afflicted by a curse According to an old account said to have been written in 1742 and describing events which had occurred a century earlier still during the English Civil War Hugo Baskerville was infatuated with a farmer's daughter He kidnapped her and imprisoned her in his bedroom She escaped and the furious Baskerville offered his soul to the devil if he could recapture her Aided by friends he pursued the girl onto the desolate moor Baskerville and his victim were found dead She had died from fright but a giant spectral hound stood guard over Baskerville's body The hound tore out Baskerville's throat then vanished into the night Sir Charles Baskerville had become fearful of the legendary curse and its hellhound Mortimer concluded that Sir Charles had been waiting for someone when he died His face was contorted in a ghastly expression while his footprints suggested that he was running
