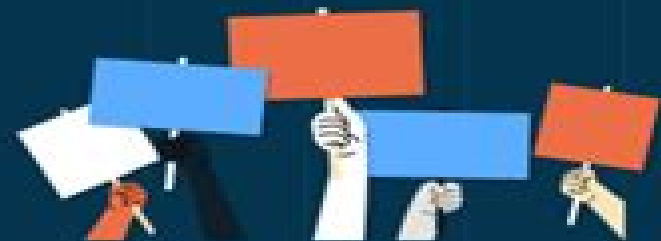


# THE TOP 10 Foreign Policy Concerns OF AMERICANS
