I. Introduction:

Electoral corruption is a form of political corruption that has its roots in electoral misgovernance. It is a concept derived from criminal law that deals with significant issues of deviations from acceptable norms of voting in an election. This could include anything from voter intimidation to bribery to forgery. Electoral corruption is systematically related to electoral rules but more generally this could include a wide range of deviant behavior that manipulate the process by which ballots are obtained. marked or tabulated or the process by which election results are canvassed and certified. Following Elklit and Reynolds (2005), it can be argued that legal independence of Electoral Management Bodies does not always lead to substantive independence and the challenge in creating an acceptable electoral governance is to be able to ensure that those in charge of administering elections are in fact independent minded and are sheltered from inappropriate pressures and inducements. Given that electoral governance is a complex process involving a wide range of actors and stakeholders, there is no scope for making one single stakeholder responsible for electoral misgovernance. However, there are two criteria that need to be satisfied for effective electoral governance. Firstly, a transparent and trustworthy election commission and secondly. accountability and integrity of key stakeholders in the electoral process. In an authoritarian or a hybrid regime the goals of electoral accountability. transparency and electoral integrity are hard to achieve as the
