FUNDAMENTAL AREAS OF ENGINEERING MECHANICS

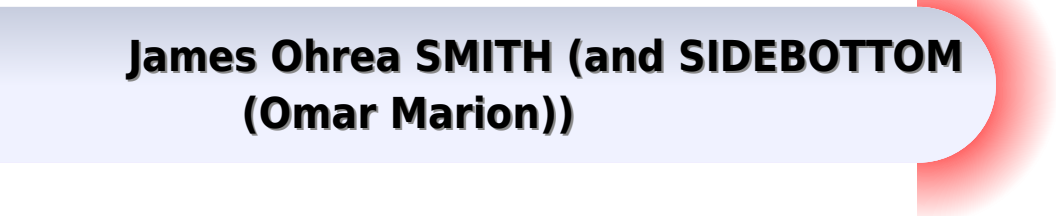
1. **Statics** - deals with the equilibrium of bodies, that is, those that are either at rest or move with a constant velocity.
