PREFACE TO THE FOURTH EDITION The Fundamentals of Tibetan Medicine is one of the most popular and widely used publications on Tibetan Medicine available in English so far This is credited to the contributions of the editorial teams of its successive editions The first edition of the Fundamentals of Tibetan Medicine was published in 1981 It has remained one of the basic learning sources of Tibetan Medicine available in English and due to an increasing interest in and demand for Tibetan Medicine and literature on the subject in 1995 a second revised edition was published In 1997 a third revised edition was published based on the existing material content and the first part of the book was divided into four chapters with the addition of an introductory section on the history of Tibetan Medicine to make it easier for the readers to understand With the growing interest demand and popularity of Tibetan Medicine all over the world the need for a fourth revised edition was felt The fifteenth Director of Men Tsee Khang Mr Tashi Tsering Phuri appointed a 4 member editorial board to revise the book because we all had our responsibilities in various Departments of Men Tsee Khang Our task was to complete the edition of the book within a scheduled time frame However because of the long hours which were needed to be
