King during the survey of the Straits of Magellan in 1827 This is an account of a detached operation in very difficult weather conditions in the western part of the strait It is introduced by remarks on the expedition and the hydrographic history of the strait from its discovery to the inception of the survey and supplemented by remarks from Captain King's account and also that of the clerk Macdougall The third text is the journal of a young midshipman in HMS Chanticleer a small vessel commanded by Henry Foster RN who had recently been elected a Fellow of the Royal Society for his scientific work in the Arctic The voyage of 1828-31 was to make observations in the South Atlantic to determine the shape of the Earth and to ascertain the longitudes of a number of ports Kay's lively diary describes the Chanticleer's encounters with warships of the Brazilian navy largely manned by Englishmen He records his struggle to take observations at Deception Island during gales and snowstorms and near Cape Horn in fierce squalls and constant chilling rain nevertheless remaining cheerful in the company of his fellow midshipmen The final piece is the diary of Jacob Wainwright
