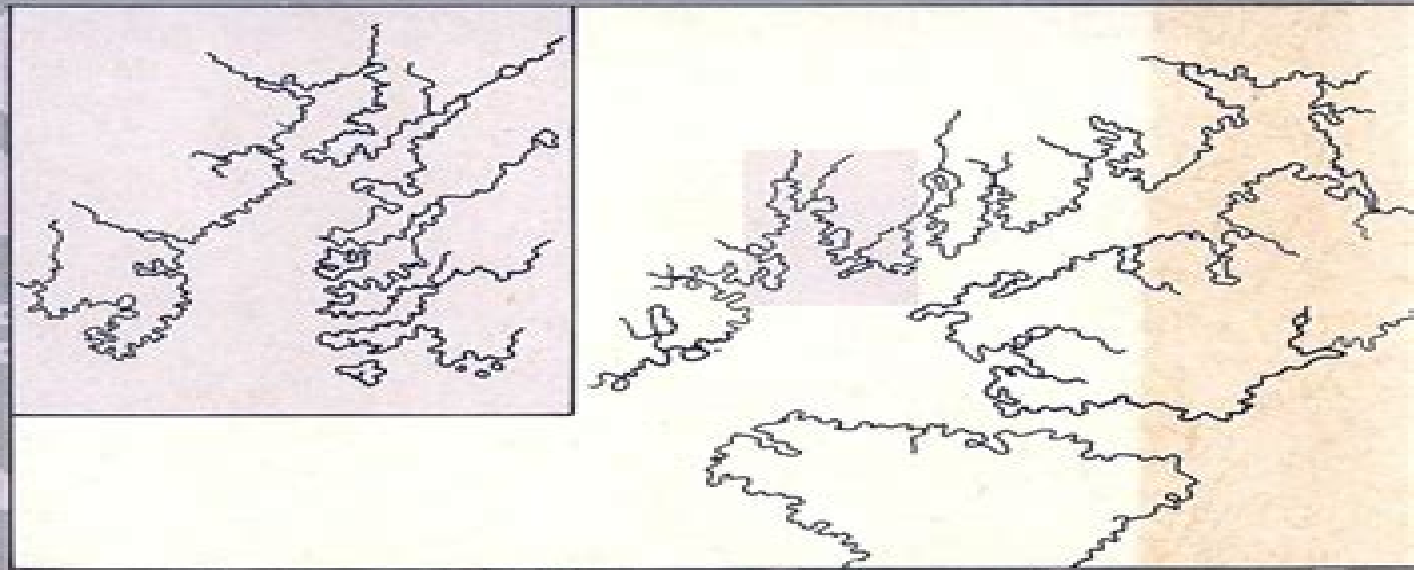

Time series analysis has been under investigations for several decades in physics, hydrology, atmospheric research, civil engineering and water resources. In chapter 11 we therefore provide fractal, multifractal, multifractal detrended fluctuation analyses which can be used to study temporal characterization of a phenomenon such as flow discharge at a specific location of a river. Chapter 12 addresses signals and again time series using a novel fractal Fourier analysis. In chapter 13 we discuss constructal theory which has a perspective opposite to fractal theories and is based on optimization of diffusive exchange. In the case of river drainages for example the constructal approach begins at the divide and generates headwater streams first rather than starting from the fundamental drainage pattern.
