Summary

In this chapter, we will examine the sociological and feminist foundations of feminist sociological theory. Feminists argue that that without gender as a central analytic category, social life—work, family, the economy, politics, education, religion—cannot be adequately studied. We will consider the way that sociology has been centered on the male, informed by male perspectives, and dominated by men until relatively recently. We will then take a brief glimpse at the feminist movements in Europe and North America and the way they may have affected the development of feminist sociological theory. At this point we will summarize European and English language feminist sociological theory in the early "Second Wave," briefly examining how feminist sociologists go about studying social life, and how they explain gendered inequality. Finally, we will pay attention to the changing field of feminist sociological theory, with contributions and transformations brought by postmodernism, the study of masculinities and sexuality, and transpational feminist scholars.

1. Introduction

Feminist sociological theory is both an academic and a political approach to the study of society. It is critical and didactic; it analyzes and informs. It is inseparable from method. Feminist sociology emerged as a response to the missing gender in classical sociology.
