OVERVIEW

The Problem:

80% of the world's primary energy comes from carbon-emitting sources that warm the climate and have significant and far-reaching impacts on human health and the world's ecosystems. We need an energy system by middentury that is at least 50% larger, emits no carbon, and limits negative impacts to society. Decarbonizing the world's \$26 trillion energy system is a complex challenge, and mainstream modeling and analysis is falling short.

The Goal:

The purpose of energy systems analysis at CATF is to characterize more rigorously the various decarbonization pathways and their economic, socio-political, and environmental tradeoffs so that policymeters and the public better understand the risks of each option. Additionally, each pathway has critical barriers and pinch points that need to be quantified and addressed to ensure their feasibility and to promote an adequate diversity of strategies to maximize our chances of success.

Technology, Market and Policy Solutions:

CATE's ambitious analysis goes beyond traditional energy system economic modeling optimization to incorporate issues of socio-political suitability, affordability, broader environmental tradeoffs, and the interdependence of other sectors.

Importantly, modeling outputs must include assessments of pathway risks and feasibility. This will enable policy decisions around deep decarbonization to incorporate the value of options and maintain flexibility to adopt in the face of unanticipated barriers, new technology developments, changes in relative costs, and political and changing social constraints.
