On land this comprises the lowest layer of the atmosphere permanently inhabited by living organisms and into which plants extend as well as the root-containing portion of the lithosphere which we term the soil. Living organisms are also found in all bodies of water to the very depths of the oceans. In a watery medium however, cycling of material is achieved by means other than those on land and the organisms plankton are so different that aquatic ecosystems have to be dealt with separately. The biosphere is therefore subdivided into a the geobiosphere comprising terrestrial ecosystems and b the hydrobiosphere comprising aquatic ecosystems which is the field of hydrobiologists, oceanographers and limnologists. Our studies are confined to the geobiosphere. Walter 1976 which constitutes the habitat of man and is therefore of special interest.
