

Some have suggested that the problem lies in the fact that much HF E research has been based on the wrong type of psychology an information processing view of psychology that is reductionistic and context free Ecological psychology offers a viable alternative presenting a richer view of human behavior that is holistic and contextualized The papers presented in these two volumes show the conceptual impact that ecological psychology can have on HF E as well as presenting a number of specific examples illustrating the ecological approach to human machine systems It is the first collection of papers that explicitly draws a connection between these two fields While work in this area is only just beginning the evidence available suggests that taking an ecological approach to human factors ergonomics helps bridge the existing gap between basic research and applied problems
