Stalin accused peasants of "war of starvation"

In a speech Stalin produced on November 27, 1932, he argued that all challenges linked with grain procurement have been the perform of saboteurs and wreckers. "It would be stupid if communists," concluded Stalin, "did not answer this blow by some collective farmers and collective farms by a knockout blow."

Collectivization was implemented with greater vigilance and ruthlessness in Ukraine than elsewhere in the Soviet Union. It was also employed as a tool to persecute the kulak class of peasant - who bitterly resisted the forced collectivization of agriculture - and in an attempt to destroy Ukrainian nationalism along with the kulaks.
