Alexithymia is a multifaceted construct that is characterized by several facets, including difficulties identifying one's feelings, difficulties describing one's feelings to others, and an externally focused, utilitarian cognitive style. In the long term, higher alexithymia scores represent risk factors for poorer mental and physical health outcomes. There is, however, a lack of systematic understanding of the underlying processes that can explain these vulnerabilities. This book shows that the facets of alexithymia influence several aspects of how one perceives and responds to neutral and emotional situations by impacting multiple cognitive processes: attention, appraisals, memory, language, and behavior. The effects are influenced by context, with some situations leading to deficits in emotion responding and others that contribute to emotional over responding.
