Rethinking Gender, Ethnicity and Religion in Iran Azadeh Kian, 2023-07-13 Winner of the Latifeh Yarshater book prize 2024 Covering the Pahlavi modern nation state as well as the Islamic regime this book examines the crucial shifts that affected Sunnite and subaltern women once Shi'ism became the state religion after the Iranian Revolution Focusing on women in the Baluchistan and Golestan provinces of Iran Azadeh Kian analyses and explores issues of cultural racialization ethno centrism Shi'a centrism and patriarchal and chauvinistic ideologies in Iranian society propagated by the state and sustained by its policies Based on quantitative and qualitative surveys taken throughout Iran comprised of over 7 000 married women and 100 interviews with a sample of Sunnite and subaltern Persian women Kian reveals how social hierarchy and power relations based on gender class ethnicity and religion operate She argues that women have been at the heart of the process of national and ethnic re construction as women as potential mothers are expected to reproduce national and ethnic boundaries Kian argues that by examining the family institution as a site of power analysing family dynamics as well as women's everyday lives the politics of ordinary Iranians and the relationship between state and society can be better understood Kian argues that the time is ripe to achieve a non hegemonic definition of Iranian national identity through acknowledgement of gender class ethnic and religious diversity and plurality of experiences of oppression and injustice

Land and Revolution in Iran, 1960-1980 Eric J. Hooglund, 2014-07-03 Carried out by the government of the shah between 1962 and 1971 the Iranian land reform was one of the most ambitious such undertakings in modern Middle Eastern history Yet beneath apparent statistical success the actual accomplishments of the program in terms of positive benefits for the peasantry were negligible Later the resulting widespread discontent of thousands of Iranian villagers would contribute to the shah's downfall In the first major study of the effects of this widely publicized program Eric Hooglund's analysis demonstrates that the primary motives behind the land reform were political Attempting to supplant the near absolute authority of the landlord class over the countryside the central government hoped to extend its own authority throughout

rural Iran While the Pahlavi government accomplished this goal its failure to implement effective structural reform proved to be a long term liability Hooglund who conducted field research in rural Iran throughout the 1970s and who witnessed the unfolding of the revolution from a small village provides a careful description of the development of the land reform and of its effects on the main groups involved landlords peasants local officials merchants and brokers He shows how the continuing poverty in the countryside forced the migration of thousands of peasants to the cities resulting in serious shortages of agricultural workers and an oversupply of unskilled urban labor When the shah s government was faced with mass opposition in the cities in 1978 not only did a disillusioned rural population fail to support the regime but thousands of villagers participated in the protests that hastened the collapse of the monarchy

Democracy in Iran Ali Gheissari,2009-07-24 In this book Ali Gheissari and Vali Nasr look at the political history of Iran in the modern era and offer an in depth analysis of the prospects for democracy to flourish there After having produced the only successful Islamist challenge to the state a revolution and an Islamic Republic Iran is now poised to produce a genuine and indigenous democratic movement in the Muslim world Democracy in Iran is neither a sudden development nor a western import and Gheissari and Nasr seek to understand why democracy failed to grow roots and lost ground to an autocratic Iranian state

Nomadism in Iran D. T. Potts,2014-03-03 The classic images of Iranian nomads in circulation today and in years past suggest that Western awareness of nomadism is a phenomenon of considerable antiquity Though nomadism has certainly been a key feature of Iranian history it has not been in the way most modern archaeologists have envisaged it Nomadism in Iran recasts our understanding of this timeless tradition Far from constituting a natural adaptation on the Iranian Plateau nomadism is a comparatively late introduction which can only be understood within the context of certain political circumstances Since the early Holocene most if not all agricultural communities in Iran had kept herds of sheep and goat but the communities themselves were sedentary only a few of their members were required to move with the herds seasonally Though the arrival of Iranian speaking groups attested in written sources beginning in the time of Herodutus began to change the demography of the plateau it wasn t until later in the eleventh century that an influx of Turkic speaking Oghuz nomadic groups true nomads of the steppe began the modification of the demography of the Iranian Plateau that accelerated with the Mongol conquest The massive unprecedented violence of this invasion effected the widespread distribution of largely Turkic speaking nomadic groups across Iran Thus what has been interpreted in the past as an enduring pattern of nomadic land use is by archaeological standards very recent Iran s demographic profile since the eleventh century AD and more particularly in the nineteenth and twentieth century has been used by some scholars as a proxy for ancient social organization Nomadism in Iran argues that this modernist perspective distorts the historical reality of the land Assembling a wealth of material in several languages and disciplines Nomadism in Iran will be invaluable to archaeologists anthropologists and historians of the Middle East and Central Asia
