Frankenstein's Children Iwan Rhys Morus, 2014-07-14 During the second guarter of the nineteenth century Londoners were enthralled by a strange fluid called electricity In examining this period Iwan Morus moves beyond the conventional focus on the celebrated Michael Faraday to discuss other electrical experimenters who aspired to spectacular public displays of their discoveries Revealing connections among such diverse fields as scientific lecturing laboratory research telegraphic communication industrial electroplating patent conventions and innovative medical therapies Morus also shows how electrical culture was integrated into a new machine dominated consumer society.
