Franz Werfel: A Life in Prague, Vienna, and Hollywood Peter Stephan Jungk, 2019-08-18 Czech born playwright novelist and poet Franz Werfel 1890 1945 became internationally famous and a special target of the Nazis after he wrote The Forty Days of Musa Dagh the first novel about the Armenian Genocide He later published the Catholic classic The Song of Bernadette written after a deeply religious experience in Lourdes a stop on his escape route to the United States through occupied France Born into a wealthy family of Prague Jews Werfel was torn between his Jewish identity and his attraction to Catholicism between high art and popular success He was friends with Franz Kafka and Max Brod in his youth and later and part of a larger Central European intellectual circle that included Sigmund Freud and Martin Buber He married Alma Schindler Mahler Gropius widow of composer Gustav Mahler and ex wife of Bauhaus architect Walter Gropius The couple fled Nazi occupied Vienna in 1938 and became part of the German exile community of California They lived in Beverly Hills where Werfel died a successful Hollywood screenwriter This lovely book is more than a biography a meditation on art history and human life John Simon New York Times Book Review An exemplary biography Edward Timms The Times Literary Supplement Jungk's description of how he researched his subject is highly suspenseful and reads like a detective story Der Spiegel This exemplary biography recalls Werfel's career and its vanished settings as part of the cultural history of the West Mr Jungk also provides a searing picture of Werfel's wife the famous Alma Mahler Gropius Werfel The New Yorker This biography ostensibly the story of a life is really a broad panorama of culture and history It is Jungk's genius to seduce us into following him into Werfel s world and to keep us there completely enthralled Die Welt The Vienna I Knew: Memories of a European Childhood Joseph Wechsberg, 2019-08-17 Wechsberg s memoir of pre World War II mittel Europa recounts with charm and irony life in the dying Habsburg Empire family stories of wealth gained and lost the subtleties of coffeehouse culture and the dynamics of Viennese society where one is at the same time an actor his own audience and his own critic His early childhood reads like an idyll so that while other writers may recall the last years of this ancien r gime as constricting Wechsberg remembers them as kindly and easygoing if sometimes philistine and stuffy However his father was killed in action on the Russian front very soon after the start of the First World War and his mother having invested her inheritance in government bonds was impoverished when the government lost the war and was dissolved Yet this is in no way a mournful book young Wechsberg found the pre war years entertaining and his inquiring wry mind makes the post war years equally so His account of a visit in the twenties to rich relatives in Vienna describing his provincial bewilderment at their cosmopolitan luxury is very funny it is also excellent social history and everybody in the story for example the chauffeur whom Wechsberg found the most comprehensible member of the m nage comes alive for us Though Wechsberg can remember himself as a country cousin his memoirs are urbanity itself The New Yorker July 30 1979 **Lives of the Novelists** Carl Rollyson, 2005-10 Is there a right way to write a literary life In this collection of columns from the New York Sun Carl

The Right to Heresy: Castellio Against Calvin Stefan Zweig, 2019-08-15 This Plunkett Lake Press eBook is produced by arrangement with Viking an imprint of Penguin Publishing Group a division of Penguin Random House LLC Castellio is a book against zealots of every kind against anything engendering the destruction of this world's divine manifoldness and injuring the humane spirit Why could Castellio not maintain himself against Calvin Stefan Zweig s answers to these questions have permanent and tragic validity it was because the masses pay tribute not only to the power of love but also to that of hatred Followers could always be found for political slogans that established enmity and divisions casting sinister flames of hatred against another religion race or class Those who sacrificed themselves for a future reconciliation of men wrote Stefan Zweig in 1933 could not escape the fact that a torrent of fanaticism rising from the shoals of human instinct would burst all dams and inundate all Castellio a fly against an elephant rose in opposition to Calvin who had condemned Miguel Servet better known as Servetus a true fighter for spiritual freedom to die at the stake To burn a man alive does not defend a doctrine but kills a man said Castellio It was an ever recurring curse that ideologies degenerated into tyranny and brute force Fanaticism indifferent to the material from which it was ignited wanted only to let the accumulated forces of hatred flame forth And Zweig utters these words six years before the outbreak of the Second World War At such apocalyptic turning points when mass delusions determine universal destinies the demon of war bursting the chains of reason hurls itself greedily and joyfully into the world In describing a tragic contest here that of conscience against force Zweig is in his element He illuminates the interesting figure of Servetus who had fought in his own fanatical hysterical manner already as a youth It is characteristic that Servetus was dubbed by his enemies Jew Turk and wicked Spaniard Zweig stressed the self sacrificing way in which Castellio defended freedom of thought against Calvin becoming the symbol of Conscience against Force And he describes most touchingly the sorrow this genuine hero had to suffer He shows too how free spirits may be endangered by the carelessness with which they choose their fellow wanderers whereas the one sided totalitarians protected by their rigidity always hold a stone ready to fling at their enemies from Married to Stefan Zweigby Friderike Zweig One
