Gelber, 2022-08-22 Ruth Klüger 1931 2020 passed away on October 5 2020 in the U S Born in Vienna and deported to Theresienstadt she survived Auschwitz and the Shoah together with her mother After living in Germany for a short time after the War she immigrated to New York She was educated in the U S and received degrees in English literature as well as her Ph D in German literature at the University of California Berkeley She taught at several American universities She has numerous scholarly publications to her credit mostly in the fields of German and Austrian literary history She is also recognized as a poet in her own right an essayist and a feminist critic She returned to Europe where she was a guest professor in G ttingen and Vienna Her memoir entitled *weiter leben* 1992 which she translated and revised in an English parallel text as *Still Alive* was a major bestseller and highly regarded autobiographical account of a Holocaust survivor It was

Während das Zwei-Geschlechter-Modell also auf die Lesepraxis nur sehr begrenzt Einfluss nimmt, wird es auf der Ebene der Selbstcharakterisierung der eigenen Lektüren vielfach fortgeschrieben. Für die Gestaltung des Leseakts aber gilt, dass weitaus gravierendere Unterschiede als die zwischen den Geschlechtern, sich zwischen Lesenden desselben Geschlechts finden. Andere Faktoren wie etwa poetologische Konzepte spielen eine viel wichtigere Rolle. Geschlecht ist nur ein Einflussfaktor unter vielen im Voraussetzungssystem der Lesenden und wird nur unter bestimmten Bedingungen zu einem besonders bedeutsamen.

Der Band untersucht die autobiographischen Projekte von Saul Friedländer und Ruth Klüger im Kontext ihres wissenschaftlichen Werkes. Sowohl Friedländer als auch Klüger betonen in ihren theoretischen Essays, dass die Interpretationen wissenschaftlicher Dokumente niemals losgelöst vom kulturellen und historischen Kontext und dem persönlichen Hintergrund des Interpreten entstehen. Eine definitive allgemeingültige Deutung historischer und literarischer Dokumente existiert folglich nicht. Dies gilt ebenso und in besonderem Maße für die Annäherung an die persönliche Vergangenheit, kann diese doch immer nur über den Akt autobiographischen Erinnerns rekonstruiert werden. Trotz ihrer Betonung der Kontextabhängigkeit von Interpretationen, die eine Vielzahl möglicher Deutungen impliziert, gehen jedoch weder Friedländer noch Klüger so weit, den referentiellen Charakter von Sprache in Frage zu stellen und die Grenze zwischen Fakten und Fiktion aufzulösen. Sowohl ihr autobiographisches als auch ihr wissenschaftliches Werk stehen vielmehr im Spannungsfeld zwischen dem Bewusstsein für die Vorläufigkeit und Subjektivität jeder Interpretation einerseits und dem Anliegen andererseits, auf eine außerhalb des Textes bestehende Realität zu verweisen. Damit nähern sich Friedländer und Klüger von den Polen ihrer traditionell entgegengesetzten wissenschaftlichen Disziplinen, an der an objektiven nachprüfbaren Fakten orientierten Geschichtswissenschaft und der Literaturwissenschaft, in deren Mittelpunkt die Auseinandersetzung mit Fiktion steht.
