

Huzel, 2017-05-15 The political economist Thomas Robert Malthus 1766 1834 has gained increasing and deserved scholarly attention in recent years As well as the republication of his works and letters a rich body of scholarship has been produced that enlightens our understanding of his thoughts and arguments Yet little has been written on the ways in which his message was translated to and interpreted by a popular audience Malthus first rose to prominence in 1798 with the publication of his Essay on the Principle of Population in which he blamed rising levels of poverty on the inability of Britain's economy to support its growing population.
