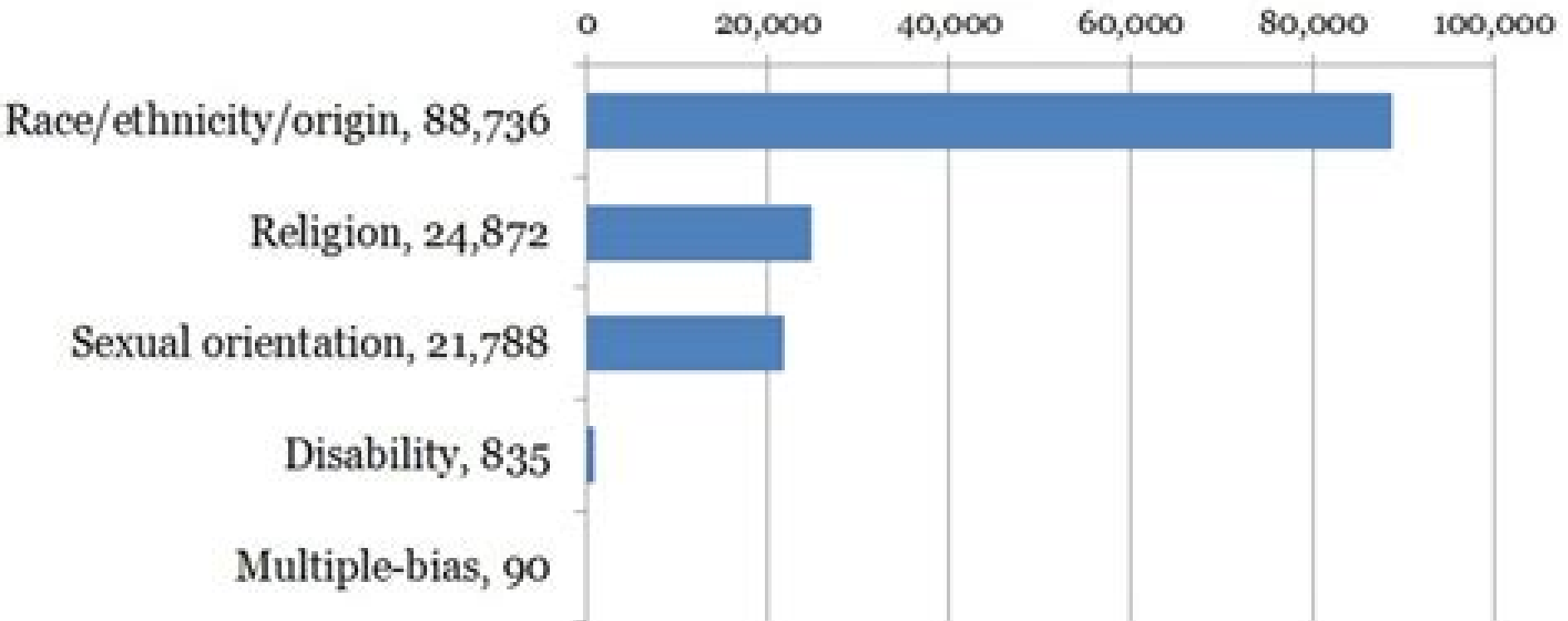


Type of incidents of hate crime in U.S. 1995-2012
