The authors argue that an analysis of these topics illuminates broad similarities among polities across the globe the transmission of ideas and technologies on a regional and global level and also important differences in the ways that societies responded to similar challenges This work is intended broadly both for specialists in the history of warfare across the globe for an interested lay public as well as for The Lost Dark Age Kingdom of Rheged Ronan Toolis, Christopher Bowles, 2017-01-31 Trusty s Hill is use in the classroom an early medieval fort at Gatehouse of Fleet Dumfries and Galloway The hillfort comprises a fortified citadel defined by a vitrified rampart around its summit with a number of enclosures looping out along lower lying terraces and crags The approach to its summit is flanked on one side by a circular rock cut basin and on the other side by Pictish Symbols carved on to the face of a natural outcrop of bedrock This Pictish inscribed stone is unique in Dumfries and Galloway and southern Scotland and has long puzzled scholars as to why the symbols were carved so far from Pictland and even if they are genuine

The Galloway Picts Project launched in 2012 aimed to recover evidence for the archaeological context of the inscribed stone but far from validating the existence of Picts in this southerly region of Scotland the archaeological context instead suggests that the carvings relate to a royal stronghold and place of inauguration for the local Britons of Galloway around AD 600 Examined in the context of contemporary sites across southern Scotland and northern England the archaeological evidence from Galloway suggests that this region may have been the heart of the lost Dark Age kingdom of Rheged a kingdom that was in the late sixth century pre eminent amongst the kingdoms of the north The new archaeological evidence from Trusty's Hill enhances our perception of power politics economy and culture at a time when the foundations for the kingdoms of Scotland England and Wales were being laid Administration and Organization of War in Thirteenth-Century England David S. Scott Jessee, 2000 This book examines the history of a prominent castle lord of eleventh century Anjou a man who has been referred to in numerous works but has never been carefully studied Robert the Burgundian was an Angevin knight whom the counts of Anjou allowed to amass enormous power on the northwestern march of Anjou Until he departed for the First Crusade in 1098 Robert was the central figure in Count Fulk Rechin's court In contrast with many studies of the period this work finds that Robert spent a long career as a major supporter of the counts of Anjou rather than as someone undermining their authority The author calls into question what is known about feudal anarchy in the eleventh century and finds that Robert and his descendants were indeed loyal to the count and were able to maintain Angevin power Remarkably records of more than one hundred legal acts involving Robert some based on his actual words survive today They reveal a richly textured life establishing family connections political alliances and relations with the Church as Robert struggled to maintain his lands and position through invasion civil war and episcopal interdict Of special interest is Robert's participation in the First Crusade after a personal visit by Pope Urban II and his interaction with the counts and the effect this had on the development of the Angevin state The book will be of interest to students of French history and politics medieval studies and military history W Scott Jessee is associate professor of history at Appalachian State
