Thus, for sixty years after Britain pulled out, the slave economies of Africa and the Americas flourished, and these powers became the dominant exporters in many markets formerly controlled by Britain. Addressing still volatile issues arising from the clash between economic and ideological goals, this global study illustrates how British abolitionism changed the tide of economic and human history on three continents.
