The author maintains that the only plausible solution to current political and ecological crises is a progressive eco populism that combines environmental justice and sustainability with economic and social justice and offers resources that can help construct a democratic and inclusive movement and culture. A progressive eco Populist vision has led to proposals for a Green New Deal and the development of the Build Back Better Act currently being considered by the U S Congress but the stalemate between progressive and conservative Democrats over the bill reveals both the compromised state of U S representative democracy and the need for a stronger movement to hold politicians and government accountable.
