Around the same time Edith was overcome with the harsh criticisms leveled by the naturalist writers Later in 1908 she began an affair with Morton Fullerton a journalist for The Times in whom she found an intellectual partner In addition to novels Wharton wrote at least 85 short stories She was also a garden designer interior designer and taste maker of her time She wrote several design books including her first published work The Decoration of Houses of 1897 co authored by Ogden Codman Another is the generously illustrated Italian Villas and Their Gardens of 1904
