He considers many individual cases in detail and gives indications on therapeutic exercises, diet and medicine. The I or self he states relates directly to the physical body and spirit and soul need to be taken into consideration when making diagnoses. Throughout the course Steiner gives valuable advice regarding the educator's own development, emphasizing the need for enthusiasm, humour and courage. As with Steiner's lectures on agriculture which stimulated the birth of the worldwide biodynamic movement, this single course has had a huge international impact, inspiring the founding of hundreds of schools and communities for people with special needs encompassing both the Camphill and Steiner special education movements.
