By crossing evenly over the dividing line between the historical and modern periods, it offers valuable insights on indigenous roots underlying some aspects of Germany's invigorating early twentieth-century architectural developments. The book chronologically examines 400 years of closely related facades concentrated in Germany but also found in Austria, the Czech Republic, German-speaking Switzerland, and nearby areas of Central Europe. While nearly 75 buildings are mentioned and illustrated, a dozen are given extensive analysis, and the book focuses on the works of three architects: Schinkel, Behrens, and Mies. Relationships between examples of these three architects' facades far transcend mere homage amongst masters. Glimmers of the system they eventually codify are apparent as early as at Heidelberg Castle in 1559 and Nuremberg's Rathaus in 1622. The book argues that in Germany, northern Gothic affinities for bisection, intense repetition, and rote aggregation intersected with southern Classical affinities for symmetry, hierarchy, and centrality, thereby spawning a unique hybrid product: the screen. Instead of graphic formality, this study is guided by on-site perceptions, propositional contrasts, means of approach, interpretive conflicts, and emotion, and it relates the design of these facades to concepts proposed by contemporary philosophers including Novalis, Hegel, Nietzsche, Freud, Adorno, and most importantly, Gadamer on hermeneutics.
