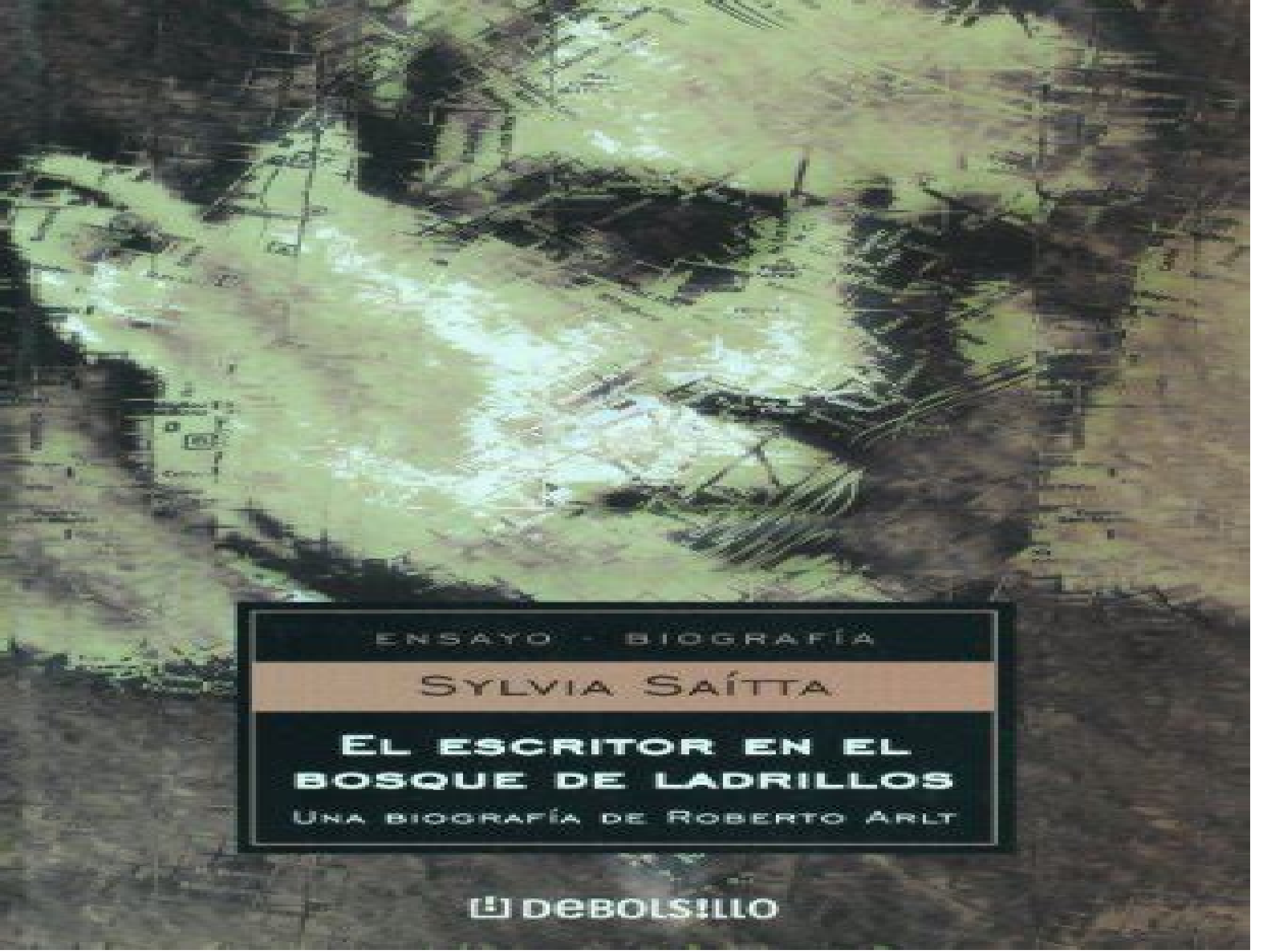

Rosenberg, 2006-04-02 The Avant Garde and Geopolitics in Latin America examines the canonical Latin American avant garde texts of the 1920s and 1930s in novels travel writing journalism and poetry and presents them in a new light as formulators of modern Western culture and precursors of global culture Particular focus is placed on the work of Roberto Arlt and Mario de Andrade as exemplars of the movement Fernando J Rosenberg provides a theoretical historiography of Latin American literature and the role that modernity and avant gardism played in it He finds significant parallels between the cultural battles of the interwar years in Latin America and current debates over the role of the peripheral nation state within the culture of globalization Rosenberg establishes that the Latin American avant garde evolved on its own terms in polemic dialogue with the European movements critiquing modernity itself and developing a global geopolitical awareness In the process these writers created a bridge between postcolonial and postmodern culture forming a distinct movement that continues its influence today **Latin American Adventures in Literary Journalism** Pablo Calvi, 2019-06-05 Latin American Adventures in Literary Journalism explores the central role of narrative journalism in the formation of national identities in Latin America and the concomitant role the genre had in the consolidation of the idea of Latin America as a supra national entity This work discusses the impact that the form had in the creation of an original Latin American literature during six historical moments Beginning in the 1840s and ending in the 1970s Calvi connects the evolution of literary journalism with the consolidation of Latin America s literary sphere the professional practice of journalism the development of the modern mass media and the establishment of nation states in the region **Argentinean Literary Orientalism** Axel Gasquet, 2020-11-24 This book examines the modes of representation of the East in Argentinean literature since the country s independence in works by canonical authors such as Esteban Echeverría Juan B Alberdi Domingo F Sarmiento Lucio V Mansilla Pastor S Obligado Eduardo F Wilde Leopoldo Lugones and Roberto Arlt The East which has always fascinated intellectuals and artists from the Americas inspired the creation of imaginary elements for both aesthetic and political purposes from the depiction of purportedly despotic rulers to a genuine admiration for Eastern history and millennial cultures These writers appropriated the East either through their travels or by reading chronicles integrating along the way images that would end up being universalized by the Argentinean dichotomy between civilization and barbarism all the while assigning the negative stereotypes of the exotic East to the Pampa region With time the exoticism of the Eastern world would shed its geopolitical meaning and was ultimately integrated into the national literature thus adding new elements into the Argentinean imaginary Latin American Mystery Writers Darrell B. Lockhart, 2004-03-30 Latin America has a rich literary tradition that is receiving growing amounts of attention The body of Latin American mystery writing is especially vast and diverse Because it is part of Latin American

popular culture it also reflects many of the social and cultural concerns of that region This reference provides an overview of mystery fiction of Latin America While many of the authors profiled have received critical attention others have been relatively neglected Included are alphabetically arranged entries on 54 writers most of whom are from Argentina Mexico and Cuba Every effort has been made to include balanced coverage of the few female mystery writers Each entry is written by an expert contributor and includes a brief biography a critical discussion of the writer's works and primary and secondary bibliographies The volume closes with a general bibliography of anthologies and criticism **The Labyrinth of Love**
