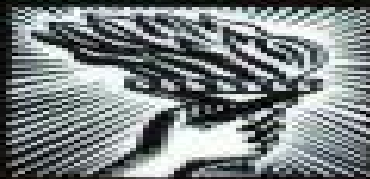

The rapid growth of Taiwan's postwar miracle economy is most frequently credited to the leading role of the state in promoting economic development.
