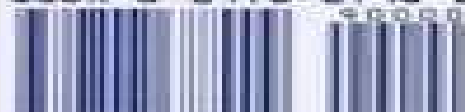

monetary terms to ethical or legal decision making processes In this respect the approach appears helpful and complementary but not beyond that
