Rethinking the French New Right Tamir Bar-On, 2013-04-12 This book focuses on the philosophy, politics and impact of the New Right which originated in France and has since influenced activism, ideology and policy in a number of European countries. This book explores the idea that revolutionaries do not necessarily need to come from the left nor use arms in order to overturn liberal democracy.
