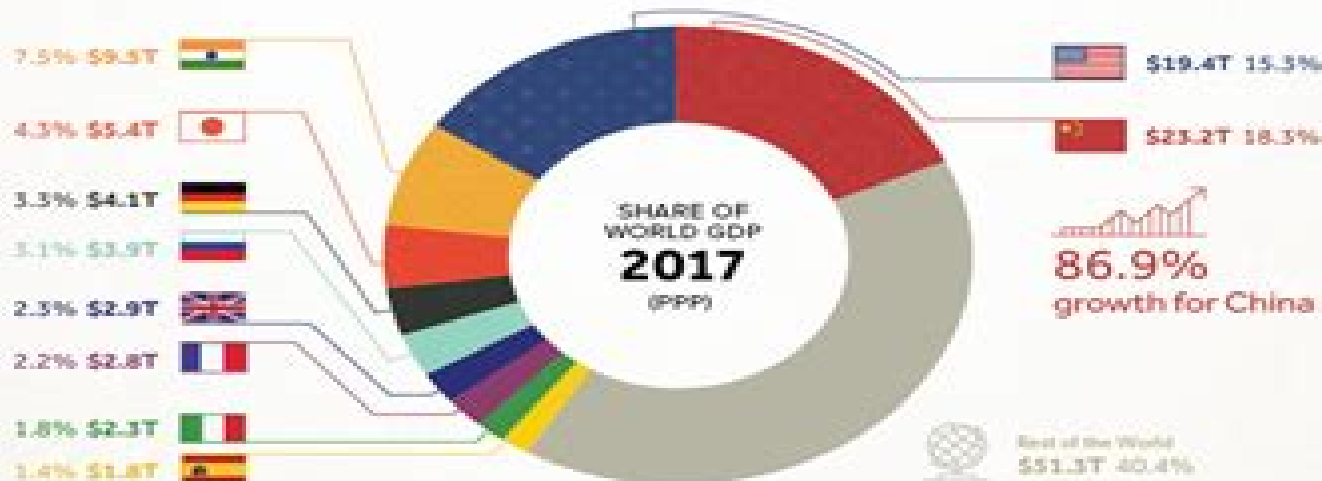
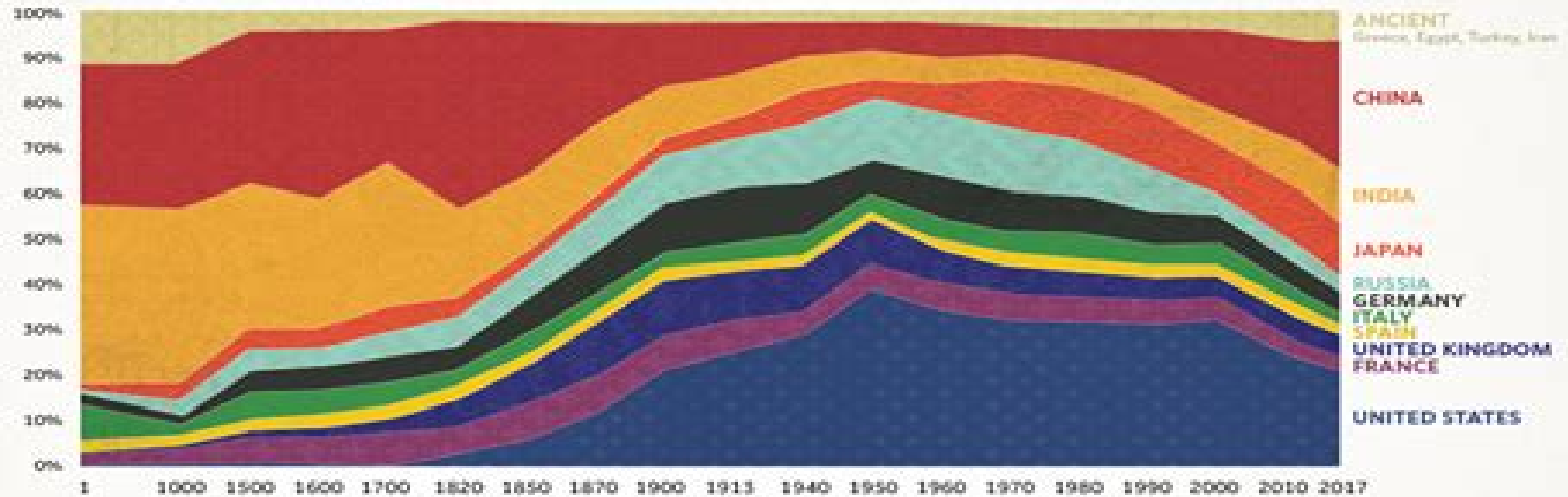


# 2,000 YEARS OF ECONOMIC HISTORY IN ONE CHART
