Thorning, 2008-09-22 On September 25 1939 Melvin Young reported to No 1 Initial Training Unit He was selected as a bomber pilot and promoted to Flying Officer Having undertaken a Lancaster conversion course Melvin and his new crew were posted to 57 Squadron at Scampton soon to become 617 Squadron On 15 May the Order for Operation Chastise was
