film as a kind of return to the real woman beneath the text Dreyer rehearsed another lifelong journey back to the poor Swedish girl who gave birth to him out of wedlock and who gave him up for adoption to a Danish family a mother whose existence Dreyer only discovered later in life long after she had died My Only Great Passion Jean Drum, Dale D.
