The SFR motif then concludes in the remainder of the Gospel. This narrative framework reveals how the SFR shapes the literary style and theological strategy of the Gospel and acts as an integrative force by giving structure and cohesion to the Gospel's symbolic system. Two key features presented in this book are a theory of symbolism and a network of symbols. The specially formulated Theory of Johannine Symbolism explains the theoretical and theological underpinnings of the Gospel's symbolic network called John's Christological Symbology. Through the symbolic network, the author of the Gospel fulfills the theological purpose stated in Jn 20:31: that hearer/readers believe in Jesus the Christ as the Son of God and thereby experience eternal life.
