

promised Holy Spirit. "He has poured out" what you both see and hear. ¹⁴ For it was not David who announced from the heavens, but he himself says:

The Lord declared to my Lord,

"Sit at my right hand

"until I make your enemies your footstool."¹⁵

¹⁶ Therefore let all the house of Israel know with certainty that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah.¹⁷

CALL TO REPENTANCE

¹⁸ When they heard this, they were pierced to the heart and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles: "Brothers, what should we do?"

¹⁹ Peter replied, "Repent" and be baptized,²⁰ each of you, in the name²¹ of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. ²² For the promise is for you and for your children, and for all who are far off, as many as the Lord our God will call.²³ ²⁴ With many other words he testified and strongly urged them, saying, "Be saved from this corrupt generation!" ²⁵ For those who accepted his message were baptized, and that day about three thousand people were added to them.

A GATHERING, GROWING CHURCH

²⁶ They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching,²⁷ to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and to prayer.²⁸

²⁹ Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and signs were being performed through the apostles.³⁰ ³¹ Now all the believers were together and held all things in common.³² ³³ They sold their possessions and property and distributed the proceeds to all, as any had need.³⁴ ³⁵ Every day they devoted themselves to meeting together in the temple, and broke bread from house to house. They ate their food with joyful and sincere hearts,³⁶ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. Every day the Lord added to their numbers³⁷ those who were being saved.³⁸

HEALING OF A LAME MAN

3 Now Peter and John were going up to the temple for the time of prayer¹ at three in the afternoon.² A man who

was lame from birth was being carried there. He was placed each day at the temple gate called Beautiful, so that he could beg from those entering the temple.³ When he saw Peter and John about to enter the temple, he asked for money.⁴ Peter, along with John, looked straight at him and said, "Look at us." ⁵ So he turned to them, expecting to get something from them.⁶ But Peter said, "I don't have silver or gold, but what I do have, I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, get up and walk!" ⁷ Then, taking him by the right hand, he raised him up, and at once his feet and ankles became strong.⁸ ⁹ So he jumped up and started to walk, and he entered the temple with them.¹⁰ ¹¹ All the people saw him walking and praising God,¹² and they recognized that he was the one who used to sit and beg at the Beautiful Gate of the temple.¹³ They were filled with awe and amazement at what had happened to him.¹⁴

PREACHING IN SOLOMON'S COLONNADE

¹⁵ While he was holding on to Peter and John, all the people, utterly astonished, ran toward them to what is called Solomon's Colonnade.¹⁶ When Peter saw this, he addressed the people: "Fellow Israelites, what are you amazed at this? Why do you stare at us, as though we had made him walk by our own power or godliness?" ¹⁷ The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our ancestors,¹⁸ has glorified his servant Jesus, whom you handed over and denied before Pilate,¹⁹ though he had decided to release him.²⁰ ²¹ You denied the Holy and Righteous One²² and asked to have a murderer released to you.²³ ²⁴ You killed the source of life, whom God raised from the dead, whom we are witnesses of this.²⁵ ²⁶ By faith in his name, his name has made this man strong, whom you see and know. So the faith that comes through Jesus has given him this perfect health in front of all of you.

²⁷ And now, brothers and sisters, I urge that you acted in ignorance, just as your leaders also did.²⁸ ²⁹ In this way God fulfilled what he had predicted through all the prophets—that his Messiah would suffer.³⁰ ³¹ Therefore repent³² and turn back, so that your sins may be wiped out,³³ ³⁴ that seasons of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send Jesus, who has been appointed

for you as the Messiah.³⁵ ³⁶ Men must repent to him and turn from all the things which God spoke about through his holy prophets from the beginning.³⁷ ³⁸ In Moses' said: "The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your brothers and sisters. You must listen to everything he tells you." ³⁹ And everyone who does not listen to that prophet will be completely cut off from the people.⁴⁰

⁴¹ In addition, all the prophets who have spoken, from Samuel and those after him, have also foretold these days.⁴² ⁴³ You are the sons of the prophets and of the covenant that God made with your ancestors, saying to Abraham, And all the families of the earth will be blessed through your offspring.⁴⁴ ⁴⁵ God raised up his servant, and sent him first to you to bless you by turning each of you from your evil ways.⁴⁶

PETER AND JOHN BAPTIZED

4 While they were speaking to the people, the priests, the captain of the temple police, and the Sadducees confronted them.² ³ Because they were accused that they were teaching the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection of the dead,⁴ so they seized them and took them into custody until the next day since it was already evening.⁵ But many of those who heard the message believed, and the number of the men came to about five thousand.⁶

PETER AND JOHN FACE THE JEWISH LEADERSHIP

⁷ The next day, their rulers, elders and scribes assembled in Jerusalem.⁸ With them the high priest, Caiaphas, John, Alexander, and all the members of the high-priestly family.⁹ ¹⁰ After they had held and John stood before them, they began to question them: "By what power or in what name have you done this?"

¹¹ Then Peter was filled with the Holy Spirit and said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders!" ¹² If we are being examined today about a good deed done to a disabled man, by what reason he was healed,¹³ let it be known to all of you and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified and whom God raised from the

dead—by him this man is standing here before you today!¹⁴ ¹⁵ This Jesus is the stone rejected by you builders, which has become the cornerstone.¹⁶

¹⁷ There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to people by which we must be saved.¹⁸

THE ACCUSERS OF THE ANCELS

¹⁹ When they observed the boldness of Peter and John and realized that they were uneducated and ordinary men, they were amazed and wondered that they had been with Jesus.²⁰ ²¹ And since they saw the man who had been healed standing with them, they had nothing to say in opposition.²² ²³ After they ordered them to leave the temple, they conferred among themselves, saying, "What should we do with these men? For an obvious sign has been done through them, clear to everyone living in Jerusalem, and we cannot deny it."²⁴ But so that this does not spread any further among the people, let's threaten them again, warning them to stop speaking about what we have seen and heard.²⁵ ²⁶ So they called for them and ordered them not to speak or teach at all in the name of Jesus.

²⁷ Peter and John answered them, "Whether it's right in the sight of God for us to listen to you rather than to God, you decide."²⁸ ²⁹ For we cannot stop speaking about what we have seen and heard.³⁰

³¹ After threatening them further, they released them. They found no way to punish them because the people were all giving glory to God over what had been done.³² ³³ For this sign of healing had been performed on a man over forty years old.³⁴

PRAYER FOR MIRACLES

¹ After they were released, they went to their own people and reported everything that the chief priests and the rulers had said to them.² ³ When they heard this, they raised their voices together to God and said, "Sirs, you are the one who made the heavens, the earth, and the sea, and the bottom, the earth, and the sea, and everything in them."⁴ ⁵ You said through your Holy Spirit, by the mouth of our father David your servant:

**Why do the Gentiles rage
and the peoples plot
futile things?**
