Celani, 2010 W R D Fairbairn 1889 1964 challenged the dominance of Freud's drive theory with a psychoanalytic theory based on the internalization of human relationships Fairbairn assumed that the unconscious develops in childhood and contains dissociated memories of parental neglect insensitivity and outright abuse that are impossible the children to tolerate consciously In Fairbairn's model these dissociated memories protect developing children from recognizing how badly they are being treated and allow them to remain attached even to physically abusive parents Attachment is paramount in Fairbairn's model as he recognized that children are absolutely and unconditionally dependent on their parents Kidnapped children who remain attached to their abusive captors despite opportunities to escape illustrate this intense dependency even into adolescence At the heart of Fairbairn's model is a structural theory that organizes actual relational events into three self and object pairs one conscious pair the central ego which relates exclusively to the ideal object in the external world and two mostly unconscious pairs the child's antilibidinal ego which relates exclusively to the rejecting parts of the object and the child s libidinal ego which relates exclusively to the exciting parts of the object.
